

### WAGE GUIDE 2018



The Labour Institutions Act (No. 12 of 2007) once again reviews the minimum wages for employees in the agricultural sector and other sectors.

The Labour Institutions Act, does not provide for the frequency of updating minimum wage. However Part VI of the Labour Institutions Act empowers the Minister of Labour to fix and update the minimum wages provided in the wages order (section 48(1).



# THE REGULATION OF WAGES (AGRICULTURAL INDUSTRY) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 2018 (w.e.f 1ST May 2018)

The agricultural sector, which is one the hardest hit sectors in the country, has over the years sustained low wages for its workers. However, much has been done by the government in a bid to try to match the employees' income to the current level of inflation recently experienced in the country. The revised wages do not however, reflect the inflation index that has hit the country since 2017 when the wages were last revised.

We highlight below the revised rates.
